Roton R.A.M.S Summer Academy

Welcome to Roton Middle School and the Middle School R.A.M.S Summer Academy. Students from Rowayton, Brookside and Columbus are invited to participate in a 5-week summer program, July 8-August 9. There is an enrichment fee of \$100 for the academy which will be used for field trips and outside vendors to provide afternoon activities. The cost of breakfast, lunch, and teachers are generously funded by the Carver Center of Norwalk.

Research suggests that one of the most difficult transition points in education is from elementary to middle school. Navigating a larger environment, excelling with grades, multiple teachers, and juggling competing priorities can be quite challenging. The Middle School R.A.M.S Summer Academy will be the necessary bridge into middle school.

Students enrolling in the program will participate in the following courses: English, Math, Science, technology and study skills. Students will take field trips to enhance team building and the academic program. Breakfast and lunch are provided for free each day.

Course Descriptions

THRIVING WITH TECHNOLOGY



Using Chromebooks, students will start to utilize Google Apps for Education to be successful. The course will focus on Google Drive, Google Classroom and the keys to using technology for learning in Middle School.

THE SECRETS OF MY SUCCESS



Using systemic organizational techniques, students will begin a success plan to address their specific organizational and time management needs. The plan will help students to plan and achieve in middle school.

GETTING TO KNOW ROTON



Roton Middle School

This course focuses on getting students acclimated to Roton Middle School. Students will learn the layout of the building including the most important locations in the building such as the nurse's office, the counseling center and the specific location of many of their academic core classes. Students will also practice opening combination locks and lockers.

LOVING LANGUAGE ARTS



This course offers students the opportunity to explore language arts through hands-on, inquiry-based, and project-based learning. The students will read, write, analyze and discuss a variety of tall tales, blogs and fairy tales along with discussing elements of literature and literary nonfiction.

Students will participate in hands-on activities to prepare for Middle School. Students will focus on Science literacy through hands-on labs and creative projects (STEM)

This course will help students bridge the gap and focus on math skills through personalized learning outlets. Students will practice the mathematical study skills necessary for success in middle school.
